Polygraphs


An instrument used to measure and record several physiological responses while the subject is asked and answers a series of questions.

A polygraph instrument is basically a combination of medical devices that are used to monitor changes occurring in the body.




Cardiosphygmograph (Blood pressure



Accuracy of the polygraph testing

There is much debate as to the accuracy of the polygraph tests.

The accuracy figures are found to be different between the statistics quoted by proponents and opponents of the polygraph technique.

Many states in the **USA** and **India** admit the polygraph testimony in court.

Most European countries and Canada consider polygraph results as unreliable evidence.

In Thailand, Thai courts reject the use of polygraph results as evidence in court. The results are considered merely information.
